AFP Foundation for Philanthropy Canada	\$403,674 3-Year Project	Inclusive Leadership	This project titled “Fellows in Inclusion and Philanthropy project” will offer a fellowship program to emerging leaders from underrepresented groups with the aim to build a truly inclusive charitable sector. The fellows will be given opportunities for professional development and advancement through workshops and webinars, mentorship, information exchange and work collaboratively in task forces to develop policies and guidelines on human resources and volunteer development specifically focused on diversity, equity and inclusion.
Canadian HIV AIDS Legal Network Inc.	\$252,170 3-Year Project	Program Evaluation	This project will develop a measurement and evaluation framework for evaluation of advocacy work. Tools and best practices will be shared more broadly to organizations both within and beyond the HIV and AIDS sector.
Canadian National Institute for the Blind	\$405,000 3-Year Project	Volunteer Management	This project will produce volunteer service training manuals and workshops on engaging volunteers in areas such as advocacy, fundraising, leadership and acting as organizational spokespeople. Curriculum modules will be produced on volunteer recognition, orientation, and engagement of blind or partially sighted volunteers, many of whom are seniors. Resources will be shared broadly with not-for-profit organizations across Ontario.
Canadian Red Cross	\$396,983 3-Year Project	Volunteer Management	This project will develop online learning modules, templates and training for key processes in volunteer resource management, including work force planning, recruitment, selection, placement, orientation, training, engagement, recognition, and evaluation that help build capacity in the design and delivery of volunteer programs.
Capacity Canada	\$405,000 3-Year Project	Program Evaluation	This project will build capacity for evaluation and strategic learning across the NFP sector and is designed to foster and sustain long-term change in NFP practices, improving the connections between evaluation, organizational development and achievement of greater social impact.

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Centre for Social Innovation	\$322,543 2-Year Project	Program Evaluation	This project will build organizational, financial and evaluation capacity in not-for-profit organizations and social enterprises by enabling the design, dissemination and electronic delivery of the Impact Canvas a stand-alone evaluation tool comprised of a graphic, an instructional guide and an online application.
Community Literacy of Ontario	\$217,739 3-Year Project	Program Evaluation	This project will focus on developing a culture of evaluation in small literacy organizations and establish a community of practice.
Foodshare Ontario	\$243,000 2-Year Project	Program Evaluation	This project will build program evaluation capacity to better articulate results and improve the methodologies used to measure project impacts for non-profit organizations who deliver food and farming programs. The project will develop assessment tools, curriculum modules, templates, manuals, and benchmarking surveys that can be used by FoodShare's 5 program areas, and versions that are adapted to additional diverse uses for the NFP food and farm sector.
Health Nexus	\$405,000 3-Year Project	Inclusive Leadership	This project will build capacity in inclusive leadership development by partnering with networks, particularly those focused on marginalized communities, to actively engage those with lived experiences, and document their innovative community knowledge. This project will foster a collaborative working environment to develop and implement resources/learning activities based on documented knowledge.
Hot Docs Canadian International Documentary Film Festival	\$241,479 2-Year Project	Volunteer Management	This project will undertake extensive marketing activities to help increase the number of volunteers participating in the cultural sector across Ontario. Activities will include promotional campaigns during International Volunteer Day and National Volunteer Week, special outreach to newcomers, and the development of a Volunteer Passport that rewards volunteer engagement with multiple cultural organizations. Curriculum, templates and materials that build volunteer management competencies to attract and retain volunteers in small to mid-sized cultural organizations will also be developed.

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La Passerelle Intégration et Développement Économique	\$337,029 3-Year Project	Inclusive Leadership	This project will reach out to over 300 organizations within the Greater Toronto Area with French Language Services capacity that serve ethno and racial minorities, Francophone immigrants/newcomers in order to raise awareness about the importance of cultural competency for inclusive leaders.
Older Adult Centres Association of Ontario	\$268,521 3-Year Project	Program Evaluation	This project will build capacity to evaluate programs by developing tools and providing training and support for organizations in the older adult centres.
Ontario Council for International Cooperation	\$405,000 3-Year Project	Program Evaluation	This project will create three training modules on project monitoring, assessing progress, and strengthening capacity to analyze and communicate results for over 300 stakeholders.
Ontario Network of Employment Skills and Training	\$385,243 3-Year Project	Inclusive Leadership	This project will create new developmental resources, use peer leadership methods and regional support networks to accelerate committed action on inclusive leadership achievement.
Ontario Nonprofit Network	\$398,071 3-Year Project	Program Evaluation	This project will build a sector-driven evaluation framework through both community research and active testing with organizations to ensure the framework materials act as a useful reference point to engage in evaluation practices. Strategic relations will be fostered for sector evaluation feedback.
Tamarack Institute for Community	\$373,037 3-Year Project	Inclusive Leadership	This project will work with not-for-profit leaders and 15 local community action teams and others across the province to host community conversation campaigns. This will inform the development of training and templates to create a culture of inclusive leadership in Ontario's NFP sector.
Toronto Region Immigrant Employment Council	\$405,000 3-Year Project	Inclusive Leadership	This project will build capacity to develop diversity and inclusion plans through online learning, in-person peer-learning and expert guidance that will benefit a wide set of organizations and networks across the province.
Volunteer Toronto	\$405,000 3-Year Project	Volunteer Management	This project will create volunteer management resources and training designed specifically for small, volunteer-run organizations. Existing resources will be adapted, such as best practices

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			and the Canadian Code for Volunteer Involvement, and other resources will be developed to ensure they effectively meet the needs, time limitations, and management structure of these groups.
WorkinCulture	\$138,045 2-Year Project	Inclusive Leadership	This project will build capacity to develop a diversity and inclusion plan by approaching the arts and culture NFP sector, with a focus on small and micro organizations that dominate the sector to participate in the development of a practical, user friendly strategy that can be used across the community.
